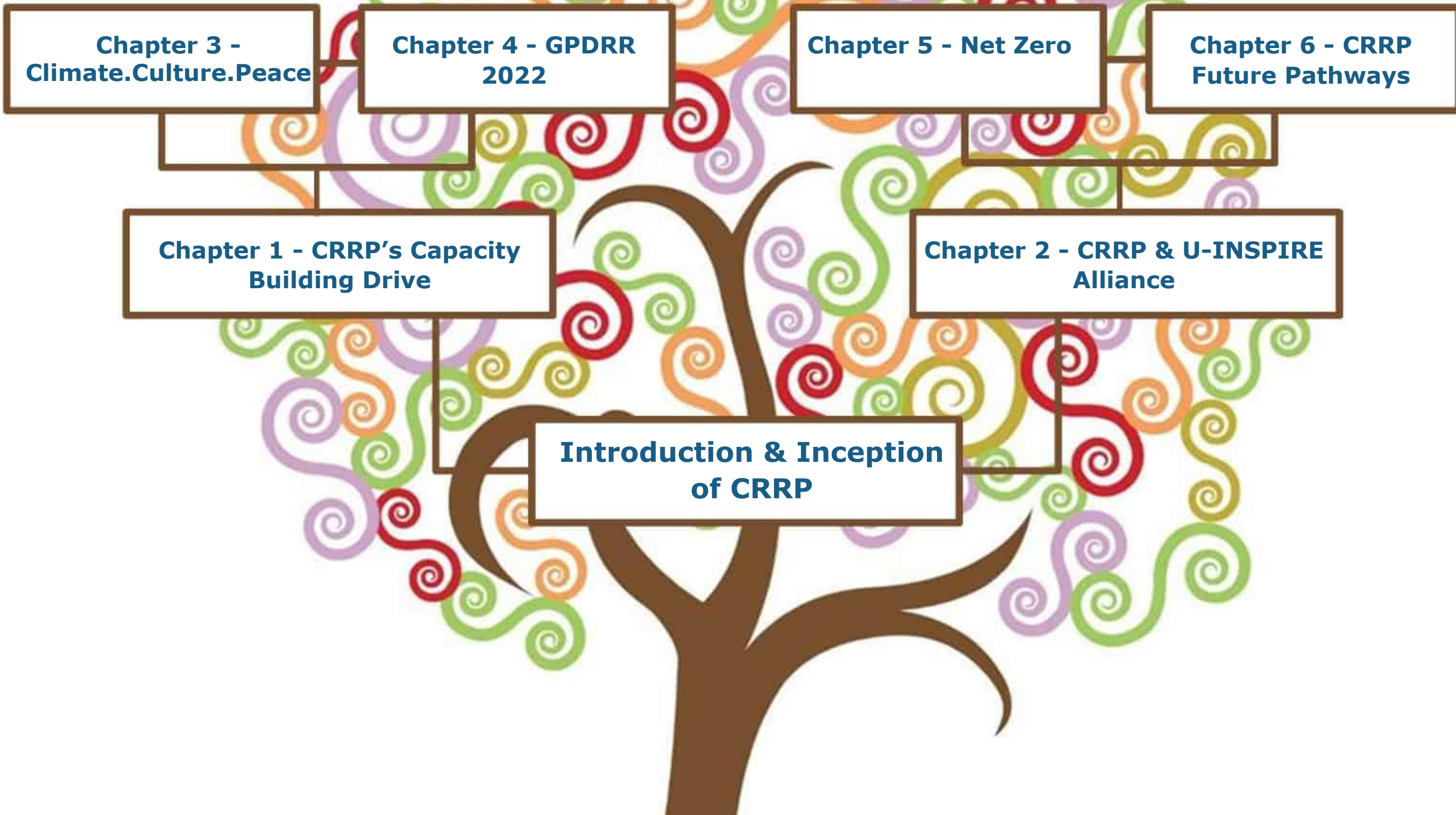

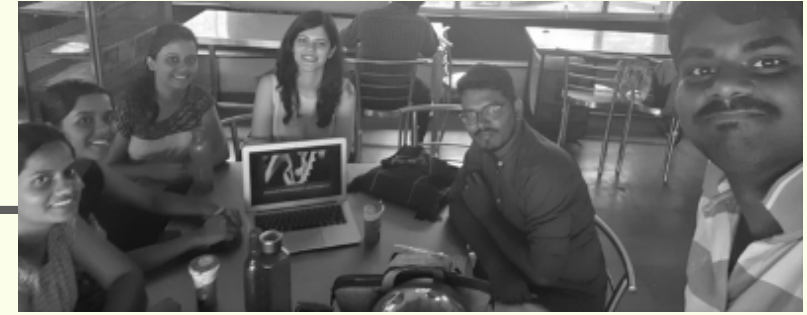

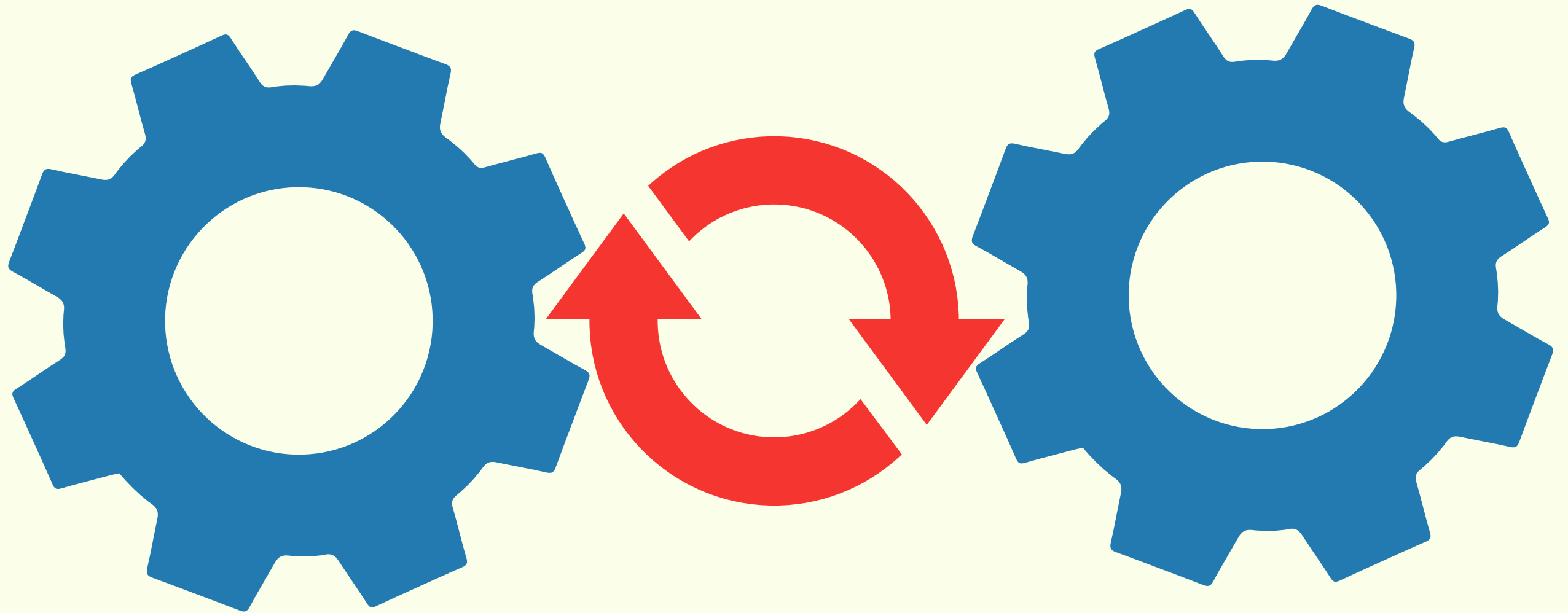
Introduction & Inception



Based on multi-city consultations of Disaster Risk Management (DRM) Professionals throughout India, the **Confederation of Risk Reduction Professionals (CRRP)** was formed with an aim to provide a platform to the YYPs to promote practical application of Science, Engineering, Technology and Innovation (SETI) for disaster risk reduction for making India disaster resilient.

It started with a WhatsApp group in February, 2019 and became a **legal entity** by August, 2019. CRRP became a part of **U-Inspire Alliance** by signing the **Jakarta Declaration** in September, 2019.

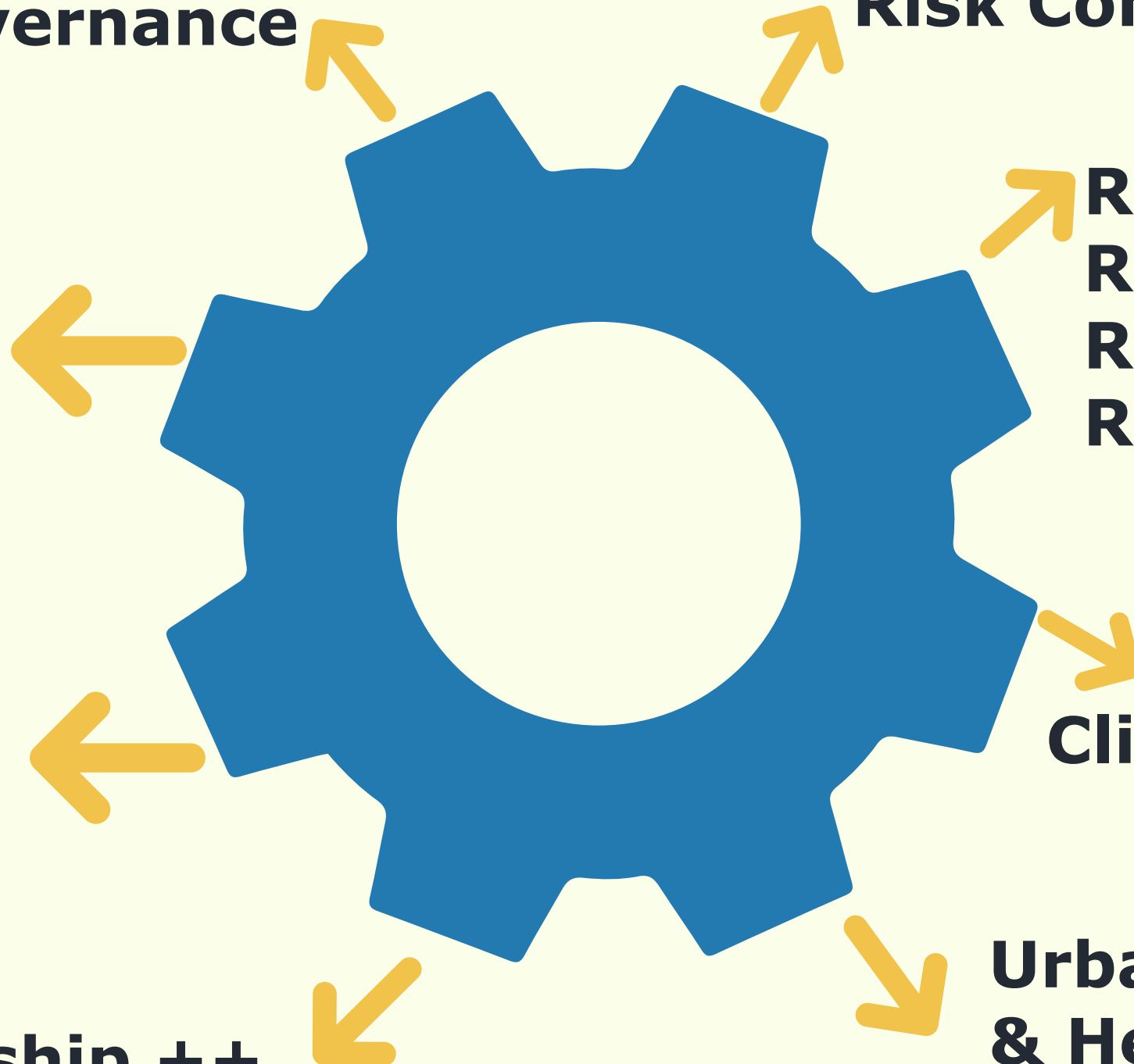

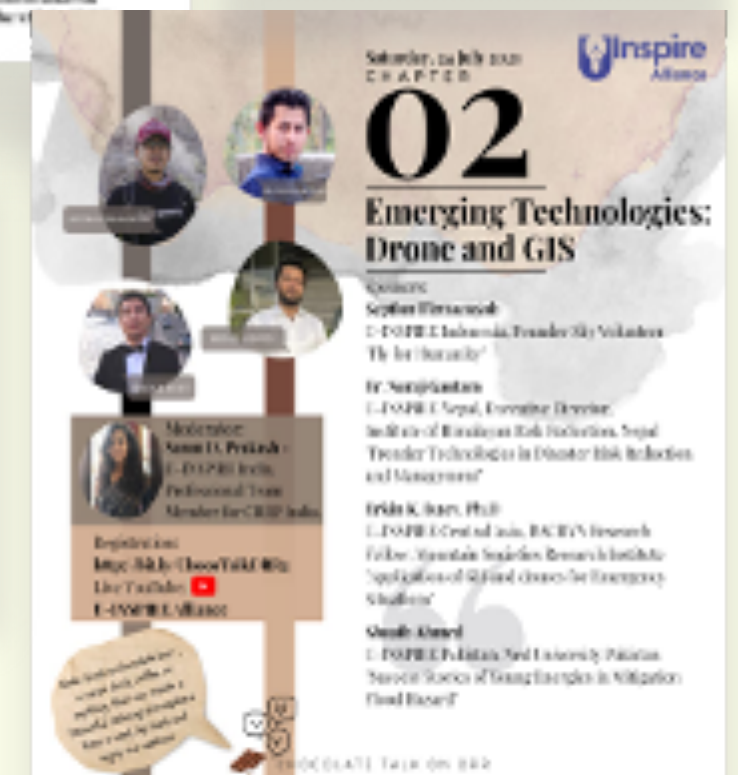

Leveraging the regional network of U-INSPIRE Alliance, CRRP ventured into various initiatives, most of which were to spark discussions and debates on contemporary topics.



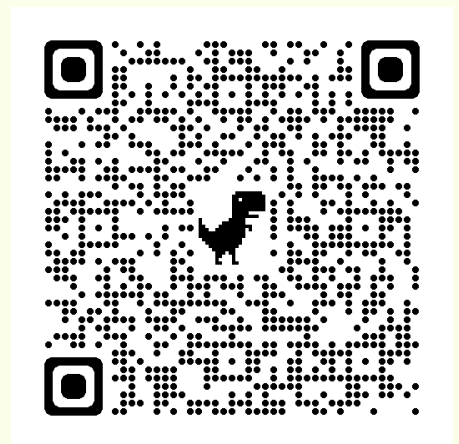

compose a musical to communicate the hard fact - Disasters are not natural!



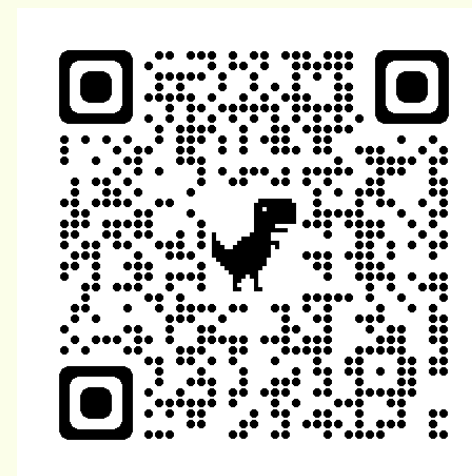

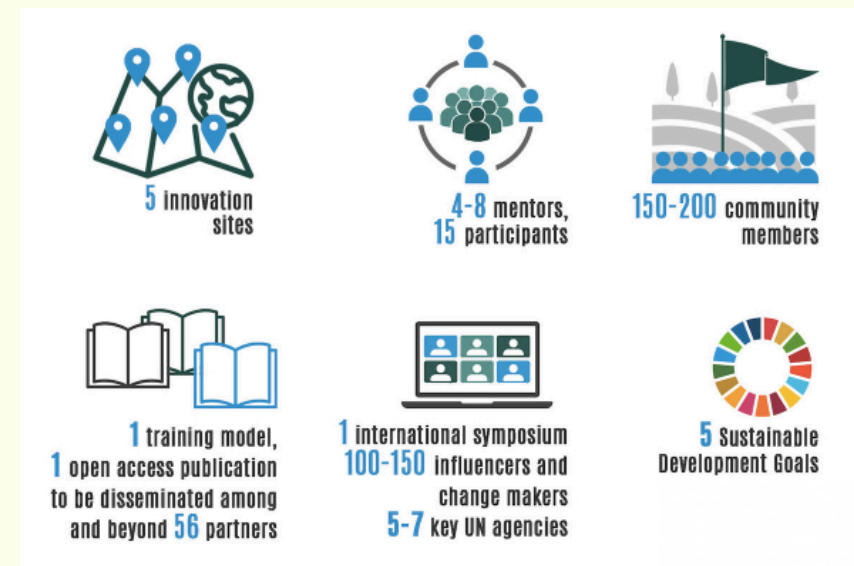
Chapter 5

CRRP has partnered with ICCROM's flagship programme - First Aid and Resilience (FAR)'s - in a new multi-partner capacity development initiative – ***Net Zero: Heritage for Climate Action***.

It is a first-of-its-kind project that seeks on-the-ground implementation of heritage-based mitigation and adaptation strategies to reduce the impacts of climate

change for people and heritage.



5 host institutions will lead transformative change at **5 innovation sites**

in 5 different regions suffering from acute environmental stresses, visible in the form of frequent extreme hazard events and/or climate-driven conflicts.
